The San Diego Workforce Partnership and UC San Diego Extension are partnering to offer a new way to advance your career. The **Workforce ISA Fund** offers access to high quality certification programs in fast-growing technology fields with career readiness, mentoring and job placement support.

What is An Income Share Agreement (ISA) offers access to education without having to worry about student loans, interest rates and decades of repayments. The fund fronts the cost of a student's education, which the student pays back in payments based on a percentage of income over a set period of time.

It's not a loan. It costs you nothing up front. And if the program leads to high paying jobs, you will pay it forward to the next cohort with a small percentage of your income.

this ISA? Since payments are based on income, no payment is owed if you do not get a job after graduation that pays you in excess of \$40,000. Payments stop if your income falls below a living wage or you experience a period of unemployment.
